

IMPORTANT REMINDERS



- Rent is <u>DUE</u> on the first of every month, and a \$50 late fee, will apply after the <u>5th</u> of the month
- THE HOUSING AUTHORITY
 HAS A ZERO TOLERANCE
 POLICY REGARDING ILLEGAL
 DRUG USE AND WEAPONS
 ON OUR PROPERTY, if you see any of this activity please call the police and then the Housing Authority office
- Please note that <u>YOU</u> can be held responsible for guests engaging in illegal behavior in your unit
- Unwelcome visitors engaging in harassing behavior can be trespassed if you call the police and the Housing Authority office
- ONLY household members listed on your lease may reside in your unit and overnight guests are ONLY allowed to stay for up to 14 days per year
- Please note that <u>A 24 HOUR</u>
 <u>NOTICE IS REQUIRED</u> for us to make copies from your file, and <u>WE CHARGE 15 CENTS PER PAGE</u>
- Especially during the warm summer months, please be careful
 when adjusting your air conditioning units to avoid maintenance issues. Thermostat should
 be set no lower than 10* below
 the outside temperature.
- In order to prevent high electricity bills, when your air conditioner is running please keep all windows closed and do not block any doors to allow your air conditioner to work more efficiently

- Do not place towels or anything else over your thermostat, this affects the sensor that detects the temperature
- Children <u>MUST</u> be supervised when playing outside
- NO INFLATABLE POOLS ARE ALLOWED!
- NOTHING may be attached to the outside of houses or on the roofs, including satellite dishes, basketball hoops, etc.
- Pets <u>MUST</u> be pre registered with the Housing Authority and have up to date vaccinations, and residents are <u>NOT</u> allowed to pet sit animals not registered with their household
- Residents <u>MUST</u> report all changes in income (such as a new job, a raise, or loss of income), <u>WITHIN 10 DAYS</u>
- IF YOU FAIL TO REPORT NEW INCOME OR CHANGES IN PAY OR HOURS TO US, YOU CAN BE PROSECUTED FOR FRAUD!
- Please call the office for all maintenance issues/ emergencies that occur during office hours 386-428-8171 X 3
- The maintenance emergency phone number should <u>ONLY</u> be called for maintenance emergencies that occur outside of office hours 386-847-3007.
- The maintenance emergency number is the <u>ONLY</u> number you should call for an emergency outside of office hours.
 Leave a message with your phone number and you will be called back. Do not call office staff after hours or go to their homes.

- Please refer to our housekeeping standards when maintaining your unit
- Residents are <u>ONLY</u> allowed one set of outdoor/weather proof patio furniture (a table and four chairs), and a barbecue grill in the yard
- Outside areas (i.e. porches and yards) <u>MUST</u> remain neat and no more than 4 potted plants are allowed
- Parking is <u>ONLY</u> allowed in designated paved areas, <u>YOUR CAR WILL BE</u> <u>TOWED IF YOU PARK IN</u> THE GRASS!
- Please note that there is technically no assigned parking, but we ask that you <u>be</u> <u>courteous to your neigh-</u> <u>bors</u> and park in the spaces closest to your unit
- Please check your mailbox frequently for important communications from the Housing Authority
 - PLEASE NOTE THAT NOT RESPONDING TO CERTAIN COMMUNICATIONS FROM THE HOUSING AUTHORITY AND MISSING RECERTIFICATION APPOINT-MENTS CAN BE CAUSE TO TERMINATE YOUR LEASE
- PLEASE PICK UP AFTER
 YOUR PETS, ESPECIALLY
 IN COMMON AREAS! IF
 MAINTENANCE STAFF
 CLEAN IT UP YOU WILL BE
 CHARGED \$25!

THE NSBH IS NOW A MOVE TO WORK ORGANIZATION. INDIVIDUALS AND FAMILIES ON SECTION 8 OR IN PUBLIC HOUSING ARE REQUIRED TO WORK A MINIMUM OF FIFTEEN HOURS PER WEEK (UNLESS EXEMPT) AND ENROLL IN THE FAMILY SELF-SUFFICIENCY PROGRAM.

ATTENTION PARTICIPANTS - 2nd NOTICE

December 5, 2024 (first notice sent July 15, 2024)

The Housing Authority of the City of New Smyrna Beach is moving into another phase of the Move To Work Supplement plan.

This phase will implement a **MANDATORY WORK REQUIREMENT** and **FAMILY SELF SUFFICIENCY ENROLLMENT** for all **able-bodied individuals** within your household.

This requirement must be met by: JANUARY 15, 2025.

Who's Exempt:

- Individuals Exempt from the Community Service requirement
- o Elderly (Ages 62 and Older) Individuals
- Disabled Individuals (Must be RECEIVING Social Security)
- o Children (Ages 18 and Younger)
- Live-In Aides
- Primary Caretakers for Children 6 years of Age and Under
- Women who are Pregnant

IF YOU DO NOT MEET ANY OF THE ABOVE EXEMPTION REQUIREMENTS,

YOU are considered able-bodied and are required to work a MINIMUM of 15 hours per work week AND must enroll in the Family Self Sufficiency program. This pertains to EVERY member of your family.

What this means for you:



If you <u>ARE</u> currently working 15+ Hours a week, <u>CONGRATS</u>, you've met the work requirement. Now you must <u>enroll</u> in the <u>FSS Program.</u>



If you AREN'T currently working 15+ hours a week, <u>YOU WILL MEET WITH</u> OUR FSS COORDINATOR to take steps to ensure you meet this requirement.

In Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher Program, when your income increases, your rent does too. This can make saving money difficult, if not impossible. However, if you enroll in the FSS program, NSB Section 8 will set up a special savings account for participants who have an increase in earned income.

Receive one-on-one Support

The FSS program will help you create a plan to achieve your goals and provide you with resources for supportive services such as:

- Employment Supports
- Continuing Education
- Housing/Credit Counseling
- And other services

MEET OUR NEWEST ADDITION TO THE STAFF, RYAN KIRBY!

RYAN KIRBY IS THE NEW SMYRNA HOUSING AUTHORITY'S NEWEST STAFF ADDITION!

RYAN CAN BE FOUND IN THE CRC OR THE MAIN OFFICE, OR MAYBE WANDERING AROUND THE NSBHA-BUT HE ALWAYS HAS A POSITIVE ATTITUDE AND A READINESS TO HELP. HONORABLY DISCHARGED FROM THE UNITED STATES ARMY IN 2011, RYAN WORKED FOR NINE YEARS AS AN AIR ASSAULT TROOPER SERVING WITH THE 101ST AIRBORNE DIVISION. LATER RECEIVING BACHELORS DEGREES IN SOCIAL WORK, CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY, AND MATHEMATICS FROM UCF, RYAN BRINGS A WEALTH OF KNOWLEDGE AND EXPERIENCE TO THE NSBHA. WITH 12 STATE CERTIFICATIONS AND 2 FEDERAL CERTIFICATIONS IN CASE MANAGEMENT AND COUNSELING, RYAN IS PREPARED TO ASSIST THE COMMUNITY IN A NUMBER OF WAYS. HIS EXPERIENCE IN CASE MANAGEMENT HAS PREPARED HIM FOR HIS CURRENT POSITION, HELPING INDIVIDUALS CONNECT TO RESOURCES, REACH GOALS, AND OBTAIN HOUSING.

IN THE CRC, RYAN HELPS PEOPLE WITH CONNECTION TO RESOURCES, OBTAINING FOOD ASSISTANCE, RECEIVING HOMELESS IDENTIFICATION CARDS AND/OR LETTERS, AND PROVIDING CASE MANAGEMENT TO THOSE IN AT-RISK POPULATIONS. WITH FSS HE GUIDES RESIDENTS IN OBTAINING FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE THROUGH EDUCATION AND EMPOWERMENT.
